He removed to Hartland from Fairfield about 1865 with wife, Lucy. He operated a general store with James Fuller, Jr (Fuller-Buck Store) at the corner of Warren Square until it burnt in 1879. He then opened his own stove and tinsmith shop on Commercial Street (seen below). After Lucy's death, he removed to Ripley to live with his son, Arthur, until his death.
