He made his way to Dover, New Hampshire where he was a large land owner.

She graduated Hartland Academy in 1902. After she divorced she began working at the Hartland Public Library in 1916 until her retirement in 1966. She was also a pianist for the silent movies being shown at the Town Hall/Avon Theater. She remained in Hartland her entire life and never remarried. Harry was a Barber and they were living in Hartland in C/1910. After they divorced, he removed to Rockwood and married 2nd Mabel (Brown) Dearborn on 26 Oct 1915 and they were living in Newport in C/1920 where she died soon after. He married 3rd Ora E. Miller on 5 Dec 1921 in Old Town and they were living in Bangor C/1930 & C/1940. He remained there until his death.

They are referred to as "Mike" & "Rosa" on the first 4 children's birth certificates with their other names written in beside them. C/1910 in Skowhegan shows him as Mike Corey and her as Cecelia. His 2 brothers, called John & Charlie, are also living with the family. After removing to Bangor about 1912 they resided at 79 Palm Street where they owned and operated a restaurant at 56 Washington Street in 1918.
