John is the first known Fuller in the New World. In 1635, at 15 years old, he came to America on the ship 'Abigail' with his older brother, William Fuller, who was 25 years old. John settled in Ipswich, Massachusetts and married Elizabeth, the daughter of Thomas Emerson who came to America in 1638 and settled in Ipswich. John removed to Salisbury about 1639, but returned to Ipswich before 1648, and was Town Surveyor in 1663; Town Commissioner in 1664; and owned land near Rocky Hill.

James was an original settler of Hartland in 1802 arriving in West Hartland around the age of 16. Fuller settled adjacent to the original 'County Road' that connected Norridgewock with Bangor running East-West through Hartland, Palmyra, Newport, Stetson and onto Bangor.

Fuller originally farmed the land, but eventually built what was to be Fuller's Tavern for traveling stagecoach passengers at Fullers Corner. The County Road originally ran past the tavern and across Route 151 (Hartland-Pittsfield road) at Davis Corner and onto cross the Sebasticook River at a former bridge that disappeared in the floods of the 1930s. The road also passed over Warren Hill and by the former 'Warren Mansion' (eventually the Perry Furbush home).

The site of the old tavern was later the location of Foster Brooks' home, although the old cellar before that was a playground for the area children. Some of the timbers from original tavern structure were used to construct what is now the Masonic Hall on Outer Main Street.

Fuller and his father signed the original petition for Hartland to incorporate as a town on January 19, 1820. He was very active in town affairs serving as Town Selectman and Postmaster.

She never married.

After graduating from Hartland Academy, Jennie attended the Salem Normal School in Salem, Massachusetts when she was 17 years old. The school, which would become Salem State College, was an all woman's school for the "preparation of female teachers" as noted in its 1871 brochure which she is noted as a student under her given name, Sarah J. Fuller.

She would then attend Boston University School of Medicine where she received her degree as a Doctor of Medicine in 1882. After practicing medicine in St Paul, Minnesota for the next several years, she returned to Hartland in 1890 to carry on her professional career practicing homeopathic medicine for the next 20 years until she retired in 1920. It was also in 1920 that she and Mrs. Mary Connelly introduced the hot lunch program at the local schools.

She was also very well known as a fierce advocate for woman's rights and is mentioned in this 1916 article; "Suffrage work in Maine was carried on for many years in the face of the greatest obstacles but there was always a small group of devoted women willing to make any sacrifice for the cause, who carried the torch until another group could take it, and every step gained was fought for. The history would be incomplete without mention of the Portland Equal Franchise League. The list of State officers who freely gave their services is too long to publish. Among other prominent workers not already mentioned are Dr. Jennie Fuller of Hartland."

According to all reports, Miss Jennie was never reluctant to express her opinion on all matters. She never married and listed her marital status on every Census as single. She lived at her father's house on Elm Street, the future Baptist Church Parsonage, during most of her adult life while in Hartland, sharing her home for many years with her sister, Harriet, who was widowed in 1903.
