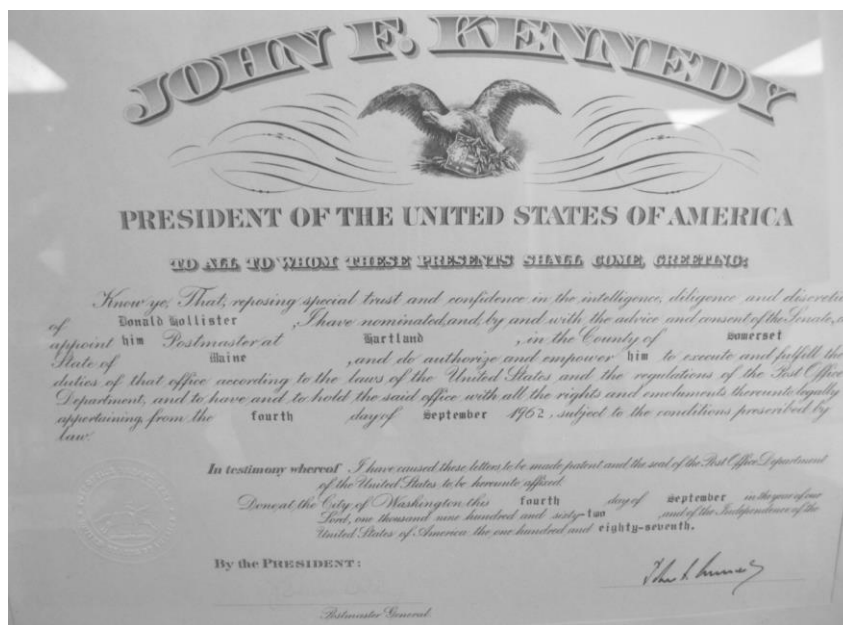

She graduated Hartland Academy Class of 1939. "Don attended schools in Detroit, Michigan and then graduated from Hartland Academy Class of 1937. He was employed by H.C. Baxter Canning Company and was later a foreman at Hartland Tanning Company. He served as a Selectman and Treasurer for the Town of Hartland and a Trustee of the Hartland School District. He also served as a Somerset County Deputy Sheriff for 20 years. Their camp on Moose Pond was known as the 'South Forty.' In his early years, Don managed and played for the Hartland Tanners baseball and basketball teams. He was an honorary member of the Hartland Volunteer Fire Department and was Post Master of Hartland for 20 years beginning 15 April 1961."
