He removed to Worcester, Massachusetts from Vermont by C/1850 and then to Hartland after his marriage to Julia although he remained in Worcester for C/1860 without her. He operated R.E. Latty Hardware in the 1870s which sat next to the Hartland Drug Store on Main Street. He built about 1890 a new building on Main Street located next to the Park House (seen below) where they lived and operated his hardware business.

Edward was a carpenter for the American Woolen Company in C/1920. The Hartland Post Office was moved around 1922 into the building his father built on Main Street with his daughter, Mildred, working as a postal clerk in C/1930.
